WHEREAS, Nick Galiotto was first sworn into office in December 2002, served as Vice Mayor and then Mayor from January 2006 to January 2007, and brought extensive experience to the City Council as a long-time resident and member of law enforcement, including serving as a Captain for the Mountain View Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Nick Galiotto served in important policy and leadership positions for the City Council and the region, including the Council Transportation Committee, Youth Services Committee, Council Procedures Committee, and served two years on the Environmental Planning Commission; and
